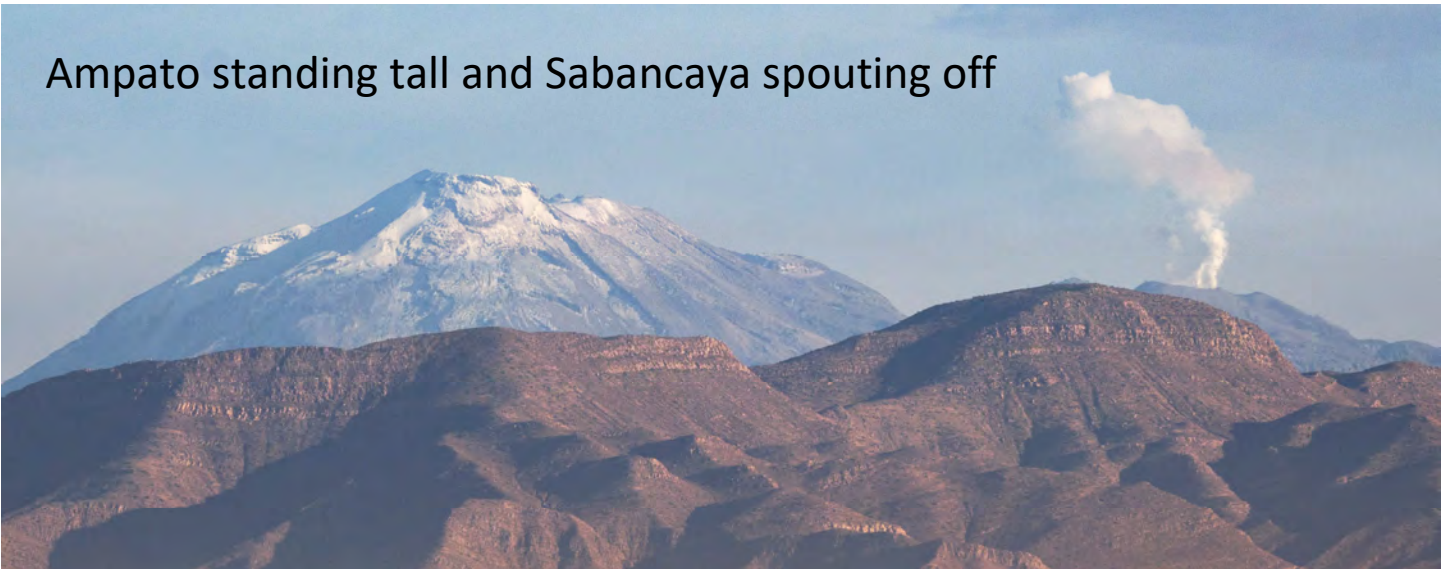


Ampato standing tall and Sabancaya spouting off

We feel that God has given him a long life in order to give him time to acknowledge his own sin and the need to find forgiveness and salvation in Jesus Christ. Please pray for his salvation.
